### DOS BOCAS – SOIL SAMPLING PROGRAM

**Vancouver, BC – November 28, 2005:** Odin Mining and Exploration Limited (“Odin”) is pleased to announce that Odin has authorized expenditure of approximately US\$65,000 initially, on a 50 x 50m soil sampling program. The purpose is to better define a specific anomaly in Ecuador identified by Newmont Overseas Exploration Limited, part of Newmont Mining Corporation (“Newmont”). The area is more specifically known as Dos Bocas, forming part of Odin’s property in Ecuador known as “Cangrejos”. Cangrejos is part of the area of interest covered by the former joint venture between Odin and Newmont, then known by Newmont as “El Joven”. This joint venture was terminated in 2001 by Newmont.

This authorized work is consequent to Odin’s ongoing review of the entire joint venture data package provided by Newmont to Odin in 2001 on Newmont’s departure from Ecuador.

Fieldwork has already begun.

The technical program is under the technical supervision of Mr. Michael Potter, MSc, MBA, MIMMM, MAusIMM, a qualified person within the definition of that term in NI43-101 of the Canadian Securities administration.

Odin Mining & Exploration Ltd. is listed on the TSX Venture Exchange (symbol ODN).
